It's also been such an exciting start as we have taken in a full intake this year! Our little ones are settling in very quickly and getting used to the new routines at 'Big School'. I'm so proud of them, as are Mrs Murphy and Mrs Lingard. I was particularly delighted to see that some of our little super stars are already starting to come into school all by themselves, which is such an important part of growing confidence and developing independence. Well done to all of you. We think you are very grown up and sensible.

More reasons to celebrate also as we think about our results from the end of the year. We performed very well at all key stages but especially key stage 2. We knew our Year 6 results were brilliant, but now national figures are becoming available we can see just how well the children performed (Have a look at the back page and be prepared to have your socks blown off!)

Finally, I'm delighted to let you know that we are inviting you to join our class dojo system!

I'm sure you know that your child can earn green dojo points for all the wonderful things they do in school. Trying hard, sticking at it, being respectful, being independent are all wonderful ways of earning green dojos. Sometimes children make mistakes or forget themselves, and red dojos are awarded — when a child is disrespectful, or not trying hard and so on. Having access to your child's account (you can't see anyone else's obviously) is a wonderful way to keep you up to date on how he or she is doing. Ask them about their dojos! Tell them how proud you are that they have been working well in their team. (Hopefully you won't have to ask them too often about what they were doing to deserve a red one!)

Apparently the system includes a messaging service, however I have requested that staff do not respond to messages sent this way. All messages for members of staff can be sent in the usual way via the office. We hope that you will enjoy finding out about your child's day to day successes.


School uniform is an essential requirement and is part of our expectation of high standards-

Breakfast Club

St Joseph's breakfast club continues to offer our children a wide variety of activities and breakfasts. All the children that already attend the club enjoy themselves in a safe, healthy and stimulating environment. Breakfast Club runs from 7.30am each day until 8.45am. It costs £2.50 per day or £10.00 per week. If you only need to access the club occasionally this is fine, just bring your child up to the school on the morning you need our exciting service and we will keep them safe and provide a lovely breakfast. If you wish your child to attend Breakfast club please use the side door near the top of the junior playground. Breakfast will not be available for children arriving at or later than 8.20am therefore allowing time to tidy up properly.

Parking outside school

Please could we politely ask that ALL Parents take notice of the timed yellow and zig zag lines outside school to avoid an accident to our children.

Please could you also avoid parking across Residents driveways where there are dropped kerbs.


