Topic

The visit to the Life Education Caravan started our Scrumdiddlyumptious topic, which is all about Healthy Eating. The children will be learning about a balanced diet. They will have a fruit tasting session, which will lead to acquiring peeling, cutting and chopping skills when designing and making smoothies. In Geography, we will study countries and cities, rivers and seas and mountains and hills.



Writing – the children will be using expanded noun phrases to describe a character and looking at regular/ irregular past tense verbs. Reading – the children will be improving their reading fluency and using punctuation when reading out loud. They will look at characters from texts and use evidence from the text to back up their ideas.
